Your safety or mine?

- Or, why safety is not self-evident and what can we do about it

In this presentation we will explore why safety is not as self-evident as some people think it is. We need to agree on what safe(ty) is, and what it isn't. This leads us to a dialogue about safety and that's just what we need, talk about safety. Not endlessly, but sufficiently. Safety is neither fixed nor a given and our insights into safety still deepen.

Frank Guldenmund is a psychologist working in the field of safety for more than 30 years. At the end of his academic career, he returns to the basics of safety science: hazard, safety and risk and the role of behavior in all of this.
